A New and Exciting U.S.-China Healthcare and Economic Cooperation Joint Venture with Newly Appointed CEO, Dr. Ming Wang

Aier Eye Hospital—the largest private eye hospital group in China, currently holding 10% of the entire China eye care market—has recently become a leading example of the major companies in China who are entering the U.S. market. Dr. Ming Wang, MD, PhD., the newly appointed CEO of Aier's entire U.S. operation--Aier-USA--discusses this exciting, historical project, which will not only provide U.S. patients with more access to eye care, but will also help reverse job loss in the U.S. by creating more jobs in this country.

Dr. Ming Wang to lead Chinese eye hospital chain's U.S. expansion

This is a story of a 15-year tenacious and persistent effort by an American—who is also an immigrant—to help America, his adopted country!

According to Dr. Wang, we want to bring jobs back to the American soil, and regarding a country like China, this can be achieved in one of two ways:

1. Selling more American goods to China. We buy so much from China today (annual trade deficit with China is \$366 billion—2/3 of the entire U.S. world trade deficit—and, as a consequence, we have lost many American manufacturing jobs to China! However, selling more goods to China is challenging due to the difference in labor costs.
2. Reverse job loss in the U.S. by creating jobs here in America, with the investment and support of foreign countries such as China.

For the past 15 years, Dr. Wang has invested and supported Aier Eye Hospitals in China, and has contributed to building it into what is now the world's largest private eye hospital group, with 154 eye hospitals throughout China.

It has taken Dr. Wang 15 years, but recently he finally convinced his Aier partners in China to come to the U.S. and invest in America's healthcare!

Just like Nissan, Aier-USA will be headquartered here in Nashville, and then it will build many centers throughout the U.S. It will not only provide American patients with more access to eye care, but it will also reverse our job loss to China by creating jobs here in America!

Dr. Wang was born in China and moved to the United States in 1982. In 2005, he performed the first bladeless all-laser LASIK surgery in China at the Shanghai Aier Eye Hospital, where he became a co-owner and serves as its international president.

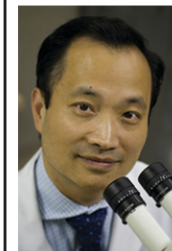
Aier operates 154 eye hospitals in China, performing 500,000 eye surgeries a year. The comprehensive eye care company is building 20 hospitals per month in China, with the goal of creating 1,000 eye hospitals in the next few years. the United States, as it is a great investment opportunity for Aier and will improve education and technology for its network of physicians.

Wang Vision Institute in Nashville, TN, will serve as a flagship for Aier and a training site for doctors to learn the most advanced technologies in the eye care field. Dr. Wang has directed Wang Vision Institute since 2002 and has performed well over 55,000 procedures, including on over 4,000 of his fellow doctors.

Dr. Wang hopes that Aier establishing a U.S. presence will serve as a model for other Chinese companies to improve economic interaction between the two countries, balance the trade deficit, and keep the United States from losing more jobs to China. Dr. Wang serves as the president of the Tennessee Chinese Chamber of Commerce and is a co-founder of the Tennessee Immigrant and Minority Business Group.

Growing up in communist China, Ming Wang came to this country with only \$50. Today, he is a world-class eye surgeon and is the ONLY surgeon in the state who performs 3D LASIK (18+), 3D Laser KAMRA and 3D Laser Raindrop (45+), 3D Forever Young Lens surgery (50+), and 3D Laser Cataract Surgery (60+).

Dr. Wang was also recently named the Kiwanis Nashvillian of the Year. He has published 8 textbooks, holds several U.S. patents and founded two 501c(3) non-profit organizations, Wang Foundation for Christian Outreach to China, and Wang Foundation for Sight Restoration, which to date has helped patients from over 40 states in the U.S. and 55 countries, with all sight restoration surgeries performed free-of-charge.
